Get to know your Driver

Since I was born I grew up watching my dad race cars at Penticton Speedway. At the age of four years old, I got into racing Quarter midgets, at the Langley Quarter Midget Association Track. I soon began to pick up on what I was doing, started winning races and moving up in the classes. The biggest race I won at LQMA was the 2014 Regional Race. It was a race that I had dreamed of winning since I started racing and I finally achieved my goal.

Come 2017, at just 13 years old, I purchased myself my first full sized hornet car. My first race at Penticton Speedway, I finished the race with zero front brakes. Although it was hardly driveable, I refused to retire from the race and brought home my very first win from Penticton Speedway. That year, my rookie year I finished 3rd in overall points and was also awarded 'Most Aspiring Driver' for the 2017 season.

For the next three seasons I raced double duty. Racing both the Hornet Class as well as the Street Stock Class. In the Hornets Class, I was the most dominant and the winningest driver, but was never able to secure a championship due to missing races. The first few years being in the Street Stock Class were not quite as successful, but a massive learning curve. My father and I rebuilt a Street Stock Camaro from the ground up. Making small to large adjustments and changes and slowly gaining more and more respectable finishes.

Just as the car was at a point of contending for a top 5 finish, it was unfortunately totaled in the first race day of the 2022 season. Luckily, we had bit the bullet and made the jump to buy a super stock, from a well known race team in Ontario that was already being delivered to us during this time. Little did we expect that the 2022 season was going to be my most dominant season yet. Winning 9 out of the 12 main event features, and winning myself my very first Street Stock title at 19 years old. Making me the youngest driver at Penticton Speedway to hold the Street Stock Championship title.

During this past season I was also offered to race in the Avion RS1 series, three different times. Twice at my home track, Penticton Speedway, and once to finish the season at Area 27, the home of Avion Motorsports. This series is the second largest series in Canada, the first being the NASCAR Pinty's series.

I never thought I would be taking my racing career to this high of a level. But I am now proud to announce that on top of my Street Stock season, I will be racing full time in the Avion RS1 Cup Series for the 2023 season. Competing against some of the best drivers in Canada!
